

Before You Start...

1. Set up your student portfolios.
2. Reserve computers with internet access for the entire unit.
3. Locate an InFocus Projector (or something similar) for the unit.
4. Make sure the students have the required pre-skills. (see the introduction.)
5. Make sure **you** have the internet knowledge to teach this unit.
6. Familiarize yourself with the evaluation and monitoring techniques used in this curriculum.
7. Have the students complete the Survey Sheet on the next page and include it in their portfolios.

Setting Up Your Unit

It is recommended that teachers browse the OLMIS web site and familiarize themselves with the OLMIS layout before teaching this unit. Note also, that because web sites are dynamic and are constantly changing and adapting, some of the links and pages may differ slightly from the way they are described in the lessons.
