

## December 2018 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

Benton County had Oregon's lowest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate at 3.3 percent in

December 2018. Other counties with some of the lowest unemployment rates in December included Hood River (3.5%), Washington (3.5%), and Multnomah (3.7%). Seven of Oregon's counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide unemployment rate of 4.1 percent and six were at or below the national rate of 3.9 percent.

Eastern and Southern Oregon had higher unemployment rates in December 2018, which were still close to their record low unemployment rates since 1990.



Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate, December 2018



Grant County registered the highest unemployment rate for the month at 7.4 percent. Other counties with some of the highest unemployment rates in December were Klamath (6.6%) and Curry (6.5%).

Harney County's unemployment rate improved over the year by 0.6 percentage point, more than any other county.

Total nonfarm payroll employment rose in all six of Oregon's broad regions between December 2017 and December 2018. The largest job gains occurred in Central Oregon (+2.3%). The Portland Area (+1.4%), Willamette Valley (+1.4%), Southern Oregon (+1.2%), the Coast (+0.9%), and Eastern Oregon (+0.8%) also added jobs.
