

Help Wanted in Northwest Oregon

Results from the 2017
Job Vacancy Survey



Northwest Oregon had roughly 3,700 job vacancies at any given time in 2017.

We surveyed 1,300 private employers with two or more employees during 2017.

If they were hiring, we asked about each vacancy's:

- ✓ Job title
- ✓ Full- or part-time status
- ✓ Permanent or temporary status
- ✓ Starting wage or salary
- ✓ Educational and experience requirements

Leisure and hospitality, a particularly important industry for coastal counties, reported the most vacancies.




Seven out of 10 job vacancies required no education beyond high school.

Northwest Oregon Job Vacancies by Educational Requirement, 2017




Average hourly wages increase along with educational requirements for job vacancies...

Average Hourly Wage for Northwest Oregon Job Vacancies, by Educational Requirement, 2017




... and high-paying vacancies are more likely to require education beyond high school.

Northwest Oregon Job Vacancies by Hourly Wage, 2017




Vacancies requiring higher education are more likely to be high-paying, full-time, and require prior experience.
