


Statewide and Local Unemployment Rates (Seasonally adjusted) Source: Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics



In November 2020, Klamath County's unemployment rate was 6.7%, up 1.2 percentage points from last year. Lake County's unemployment rate was 4.8%, up 0.7 percentage points over last year. Education and health services, mining and logging are the two industries with the biggest losses in November.

The Graph of the Month was taken from a recent article created by Jessica Nelson, Employment Economist. The article gives details on how the COVID-19 pandemic has impacted Oregon's community colleges. Enrollment across the state has dropped 23% since the fall of 2019. The community college headcount had been declining for some time, this graph shows the pandemic-driven acceleration of this trend. 
Graph of the Month Oregon Community College Enrollment Declines in 2020 Source: Oregon Employment Department and Oregon Higher Education Commission




