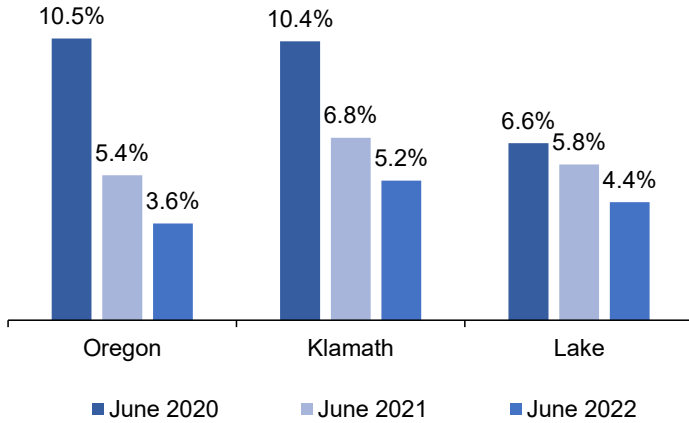

Statewide and Local Unemployment Rates (Seasonally adjusted)

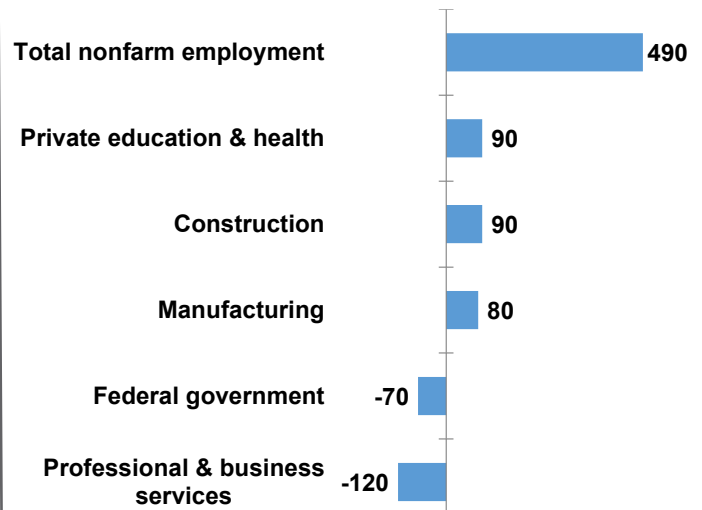

Selected Industry Gains and Losses (Over-the-year net employment change)

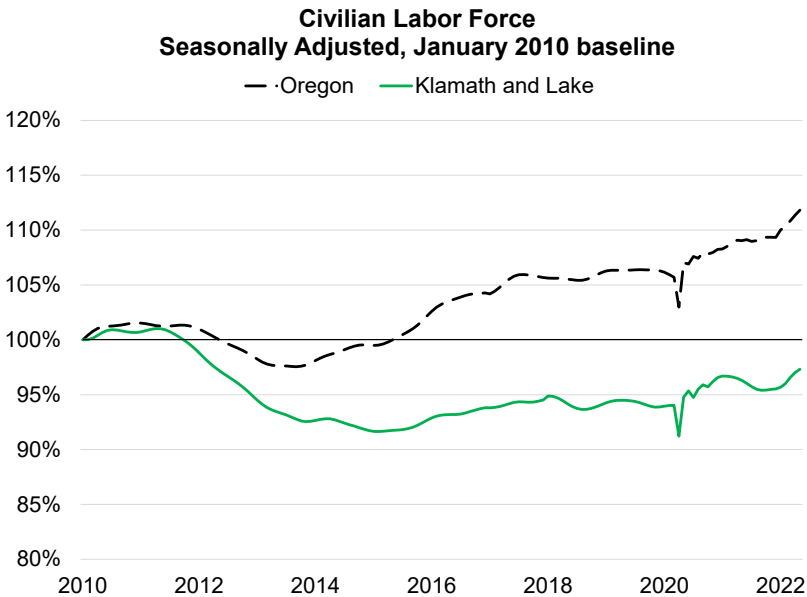

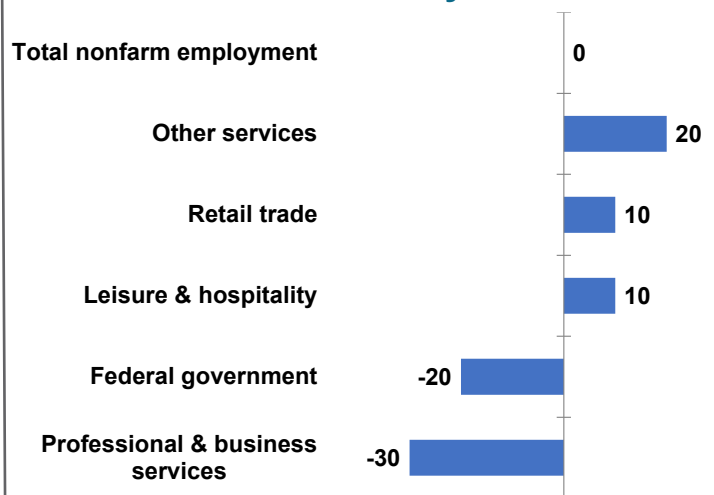

Despite the ongoing difficulty businesses have finding workers, the labor force in most parts of Oregon is larger than before the COVID pandemic. Klamath and Lake's labor force has actually grown since 2020. However, the total number of workers in South Central Oregon has declined slightly relative to 2010, which was during the previous recession.
