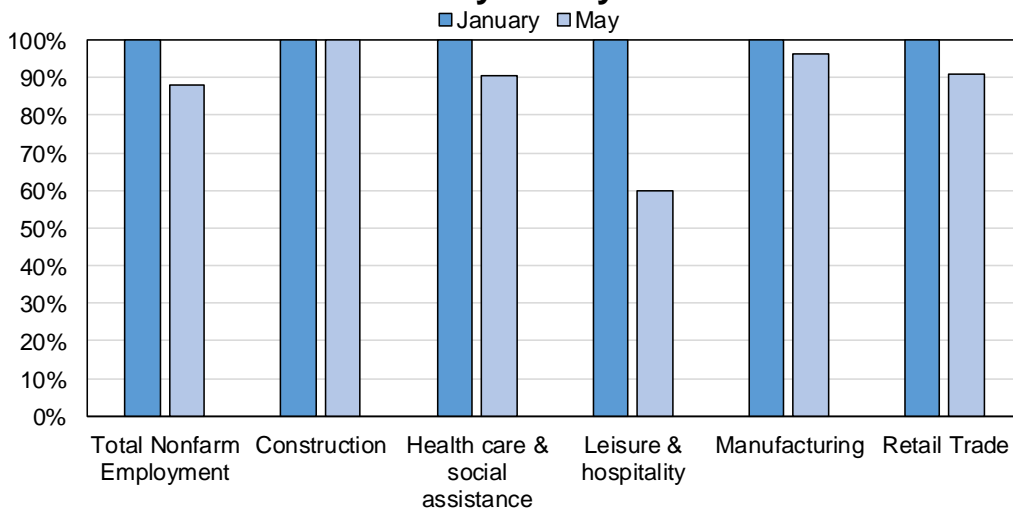


LANE COUNTY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

Graph of the Month: Job losses reversed slightly in many industries in May from the month prior in Oregon and Lane County. That good news is tempered by the fact that most industries have a long way to go to recover employment. Leisure and hospitality in particular was at 60 percent of the level employed in January 2020.
