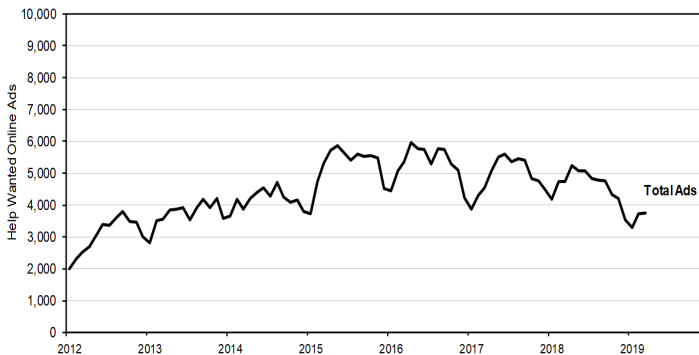


ROGUE VALLEY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

March 2019	Unemployment Rates	Nonfarm Jobs
Jackson County	4.9 %	89,410
Josephine County	5.4 %	27,300

Employment grew over the year in both Jackson County and Josephine County, at 1.9 and 2.9 percent growth rates, respectively. However, the Help Wanted Online Index (internet job listings) for the Rogue Valley shows a 21 percent decline in the past year. This may indicate slower employment growth in the near future.

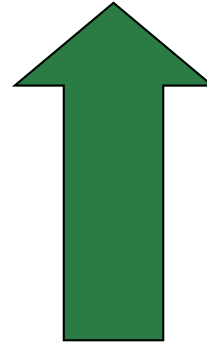

by sector, March 2018 - March 2019



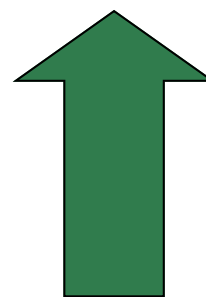
