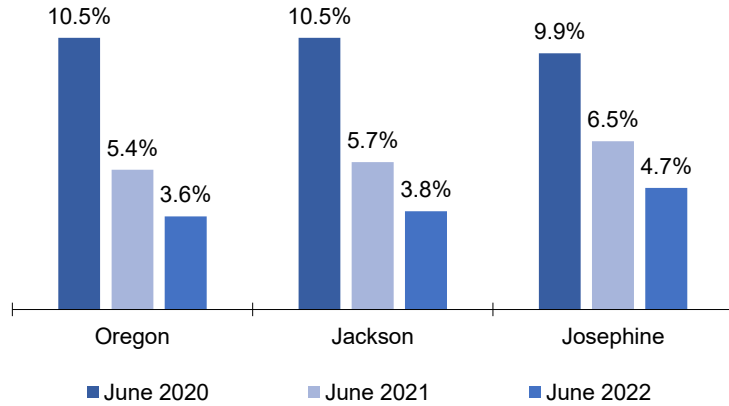

Statewide and Local Unemployment Rates (Seasonally adjusted)

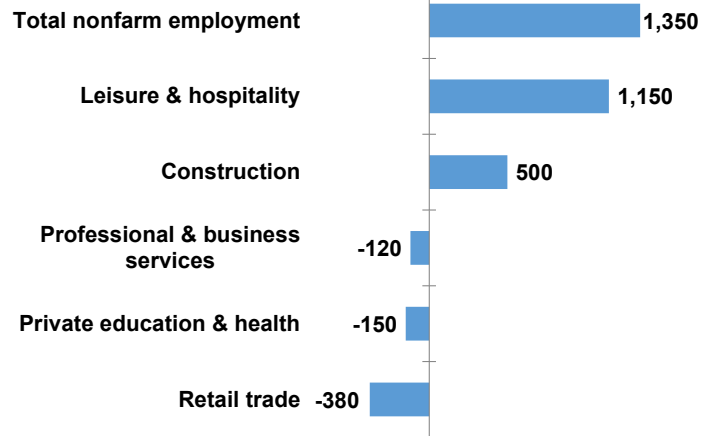

Selected Industry Gains and Losses (Over-the-year net employment change)

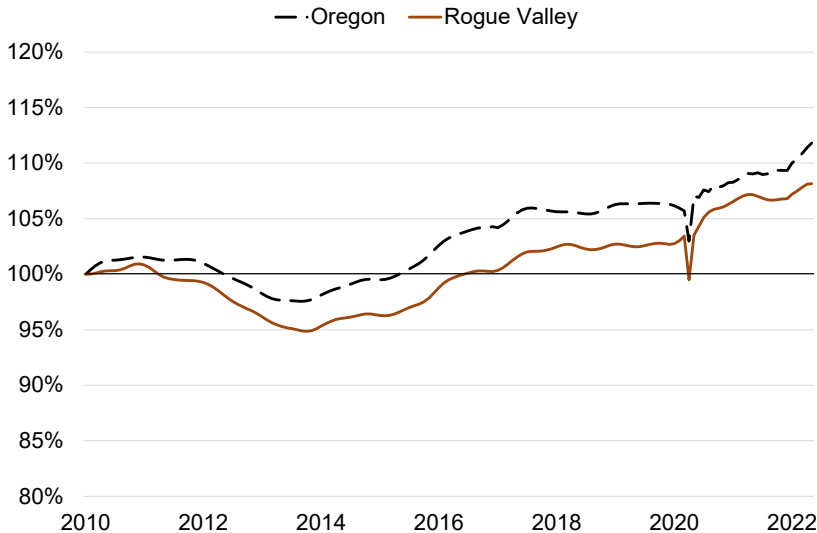

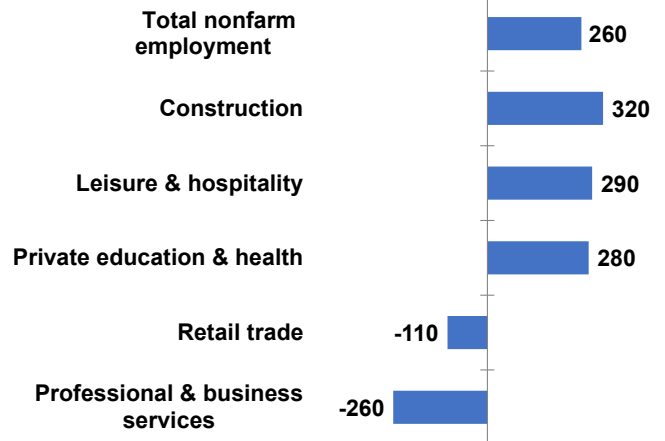
Graph of the Month Growth in the Labor Force Since 2010 Source: Oregon Employment Department

Despite the ongoing difficulty businesses have finding workers, the labor force in most parts of Oregon is larger than before the COVID pandemic. The Rogue Valley labor force has grown since 2020, at nearly the same rate as the state's. The number of workers is 8% higher than in 2010, the most growth for any Oregon region from Lane County to the south.
