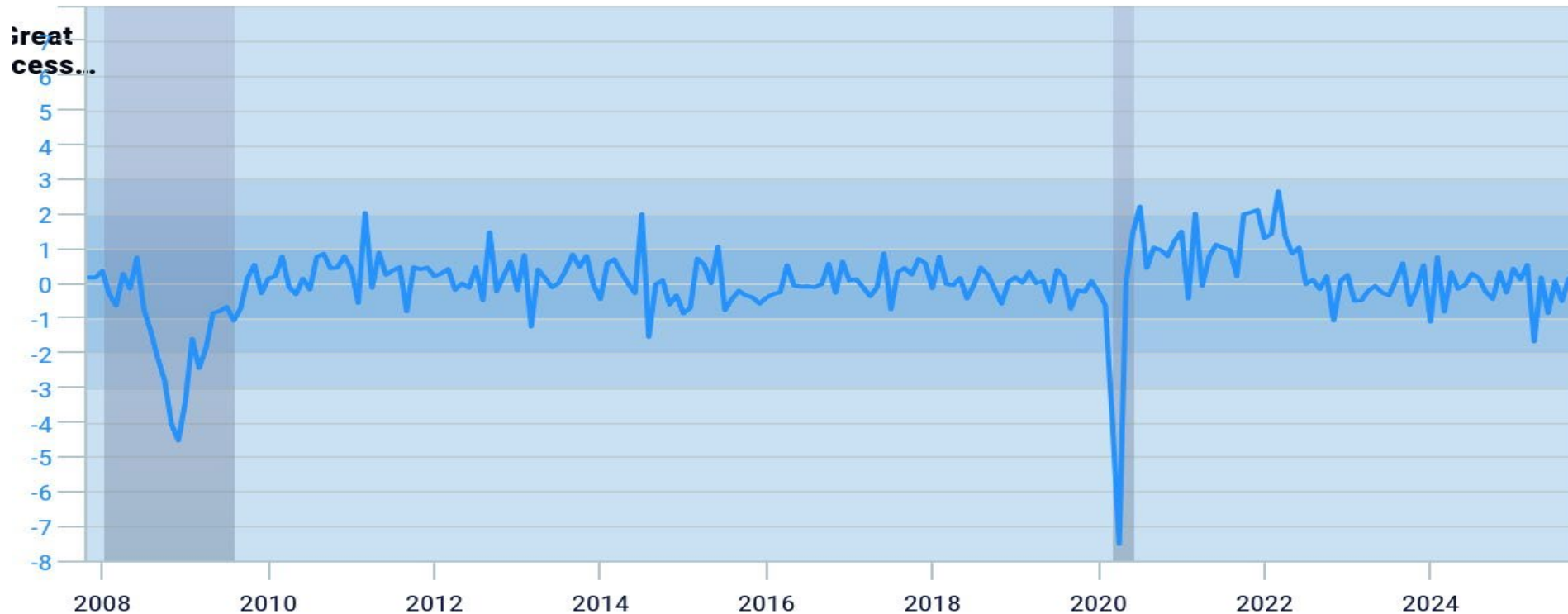
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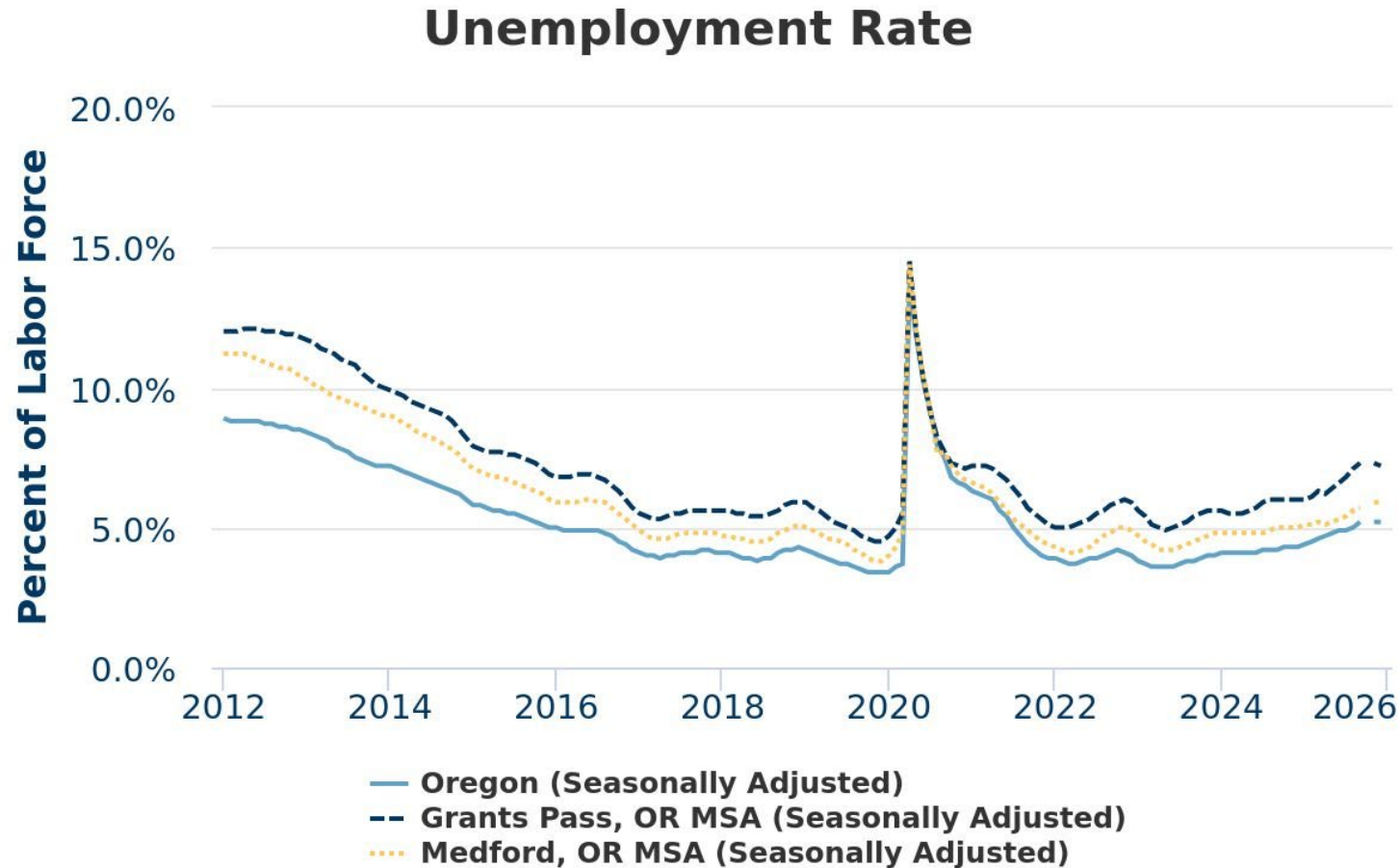

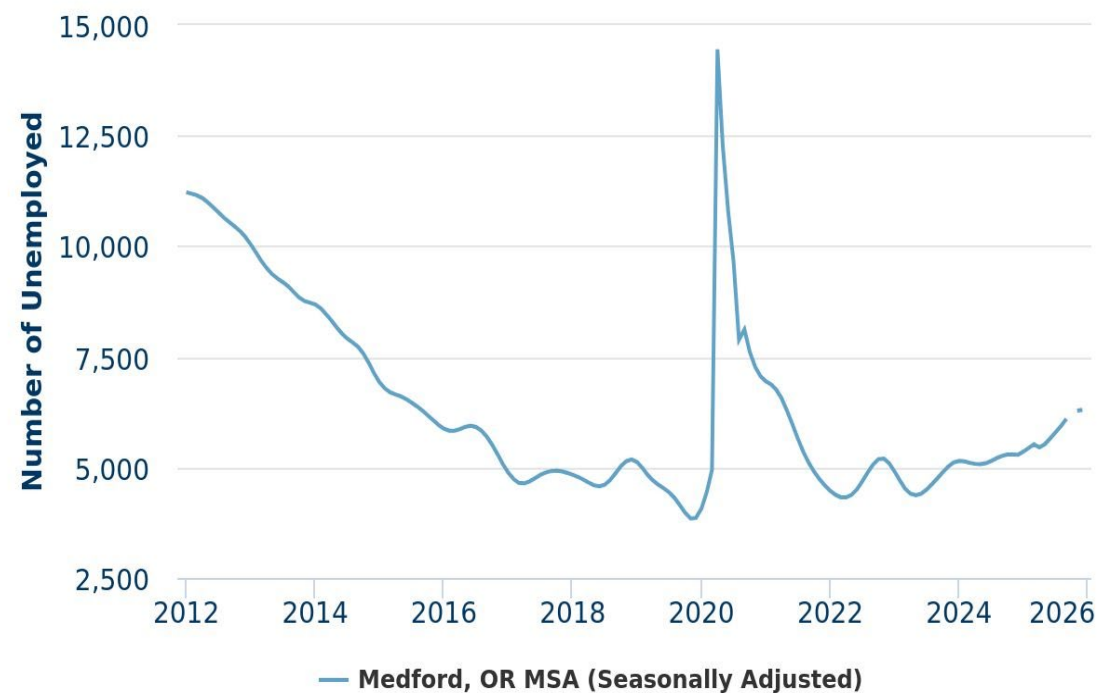

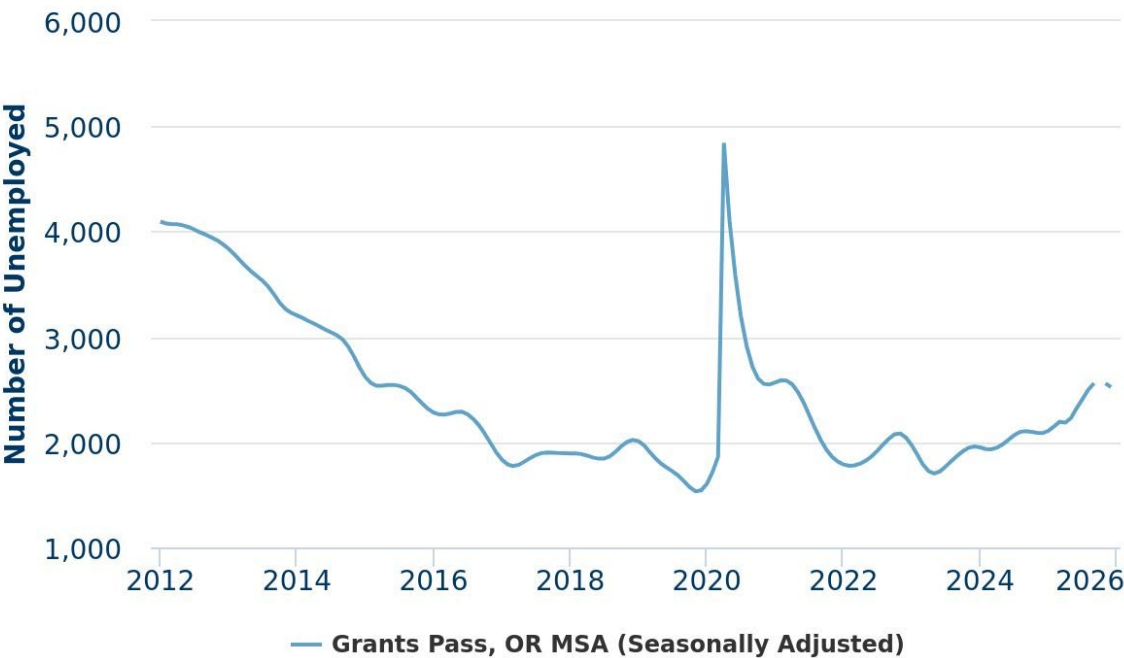

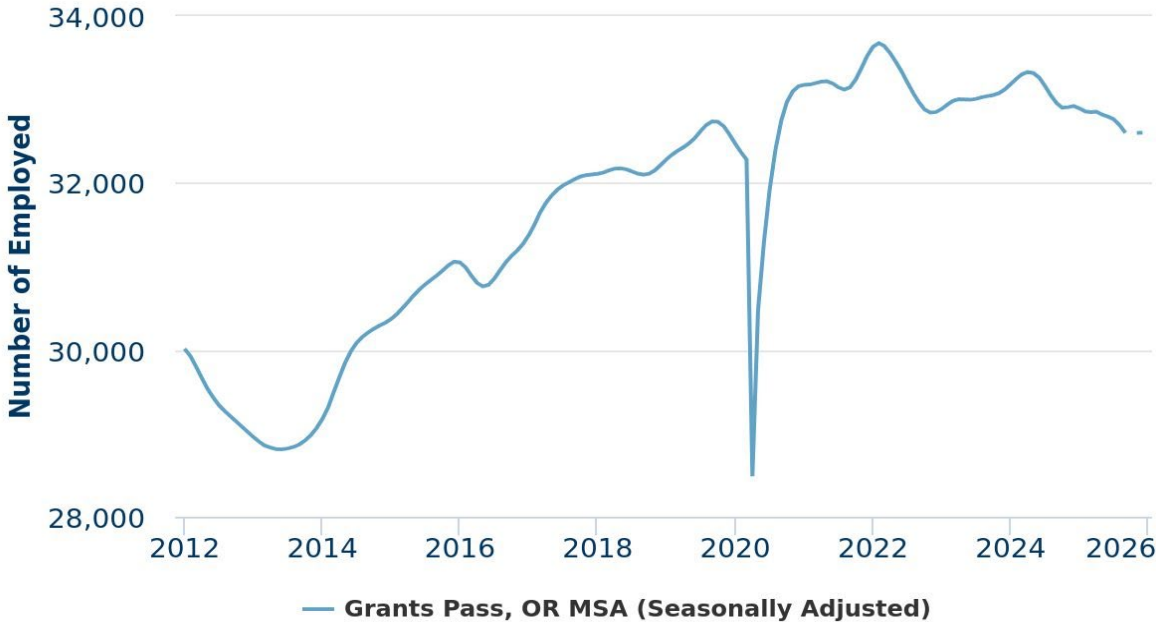
# ROGUE VALLEY SEEING RISING NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED

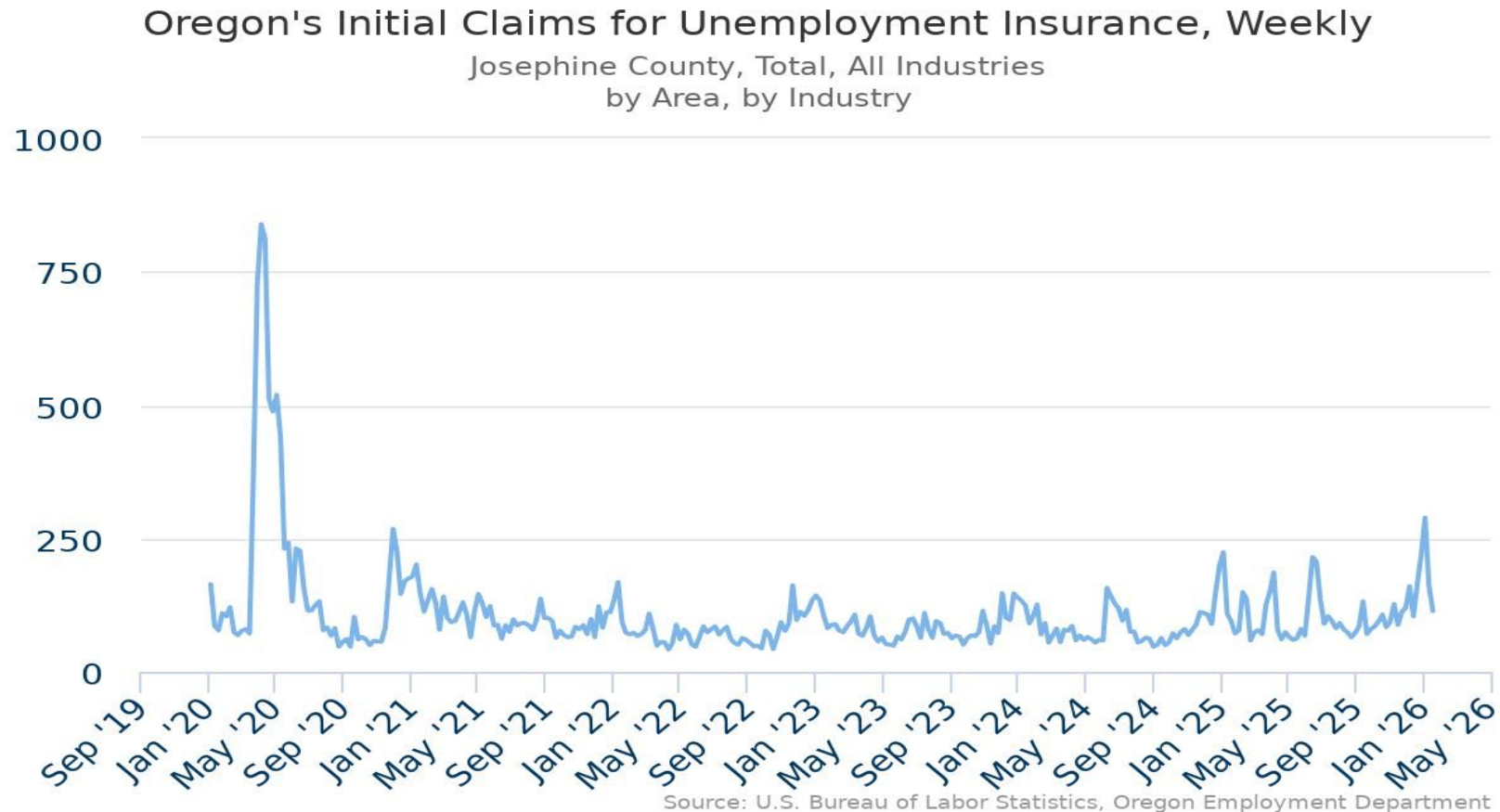

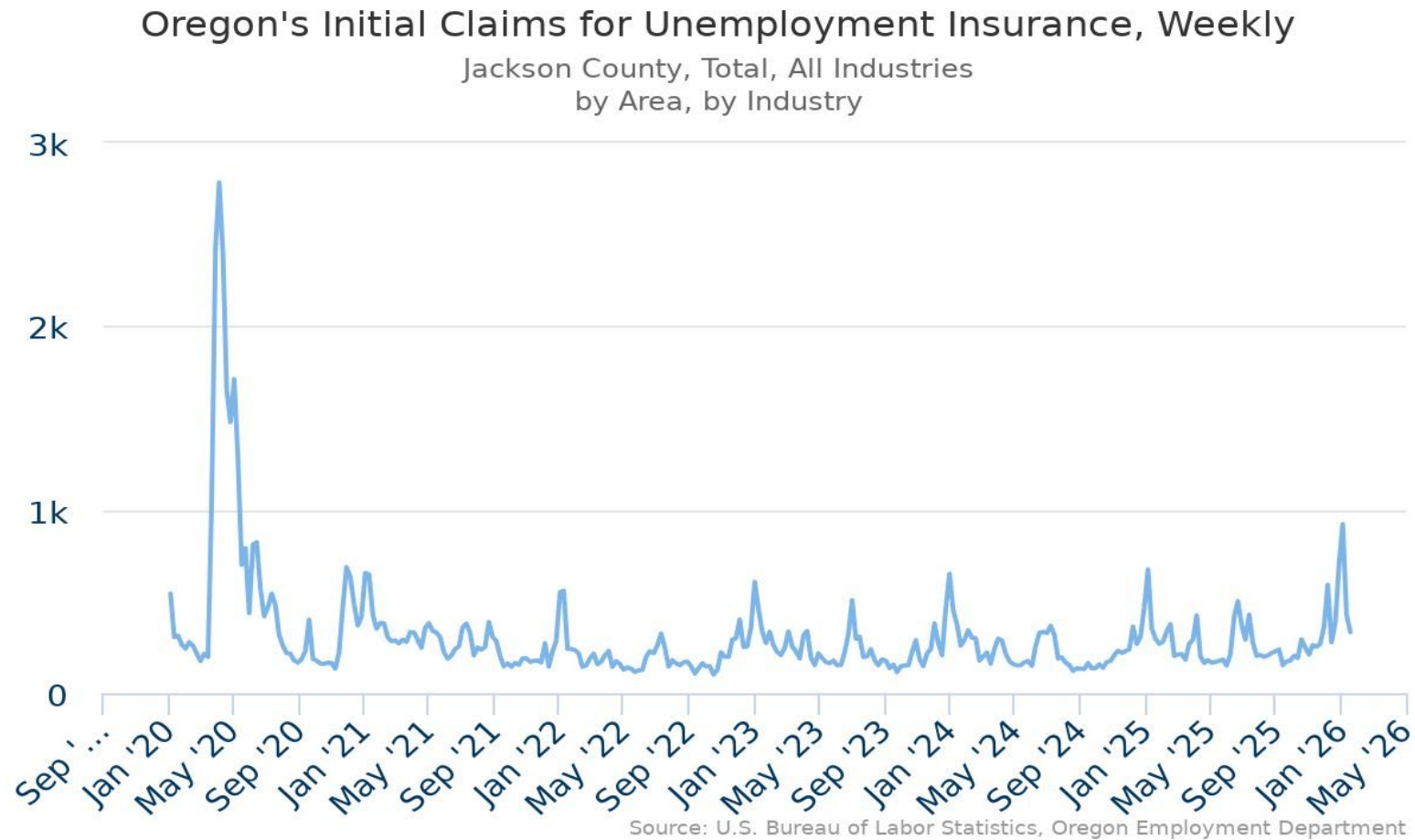
## New initial claims for unemployment insurance rising in Josephine County.

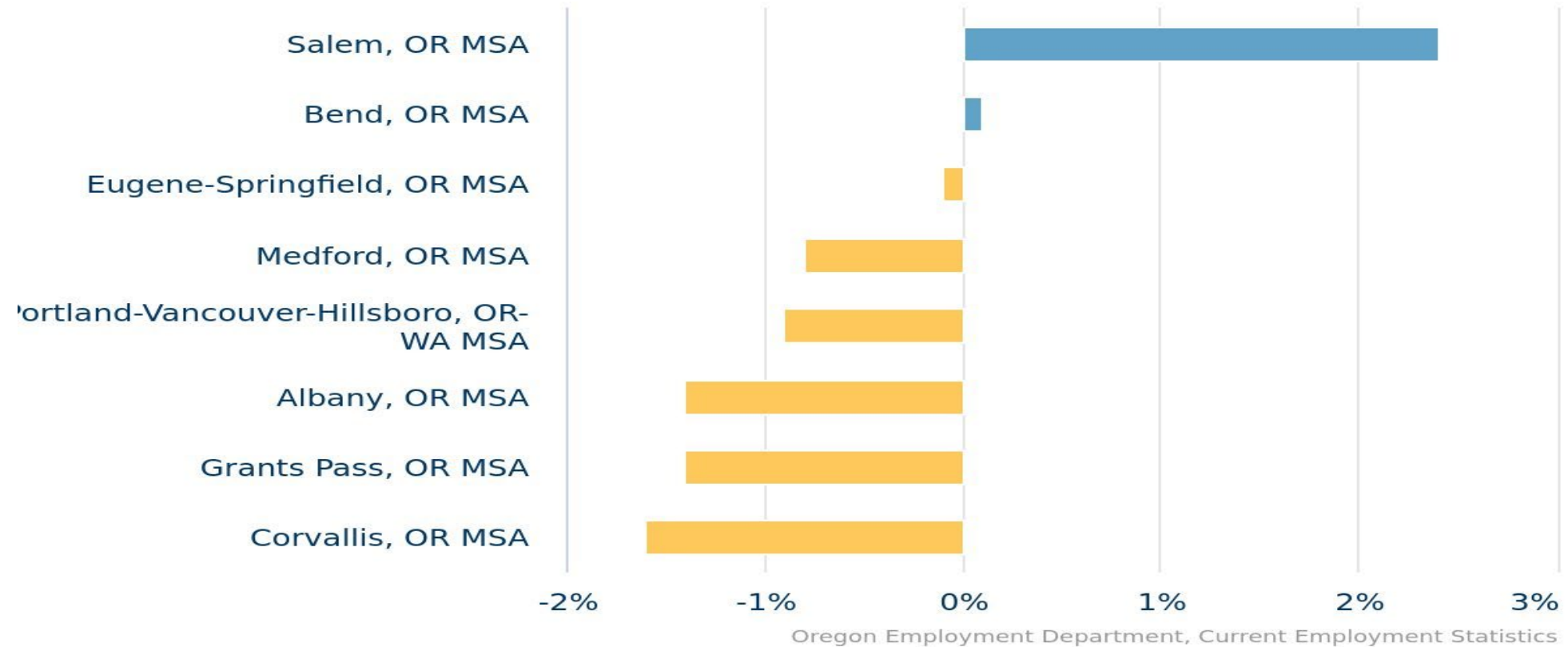

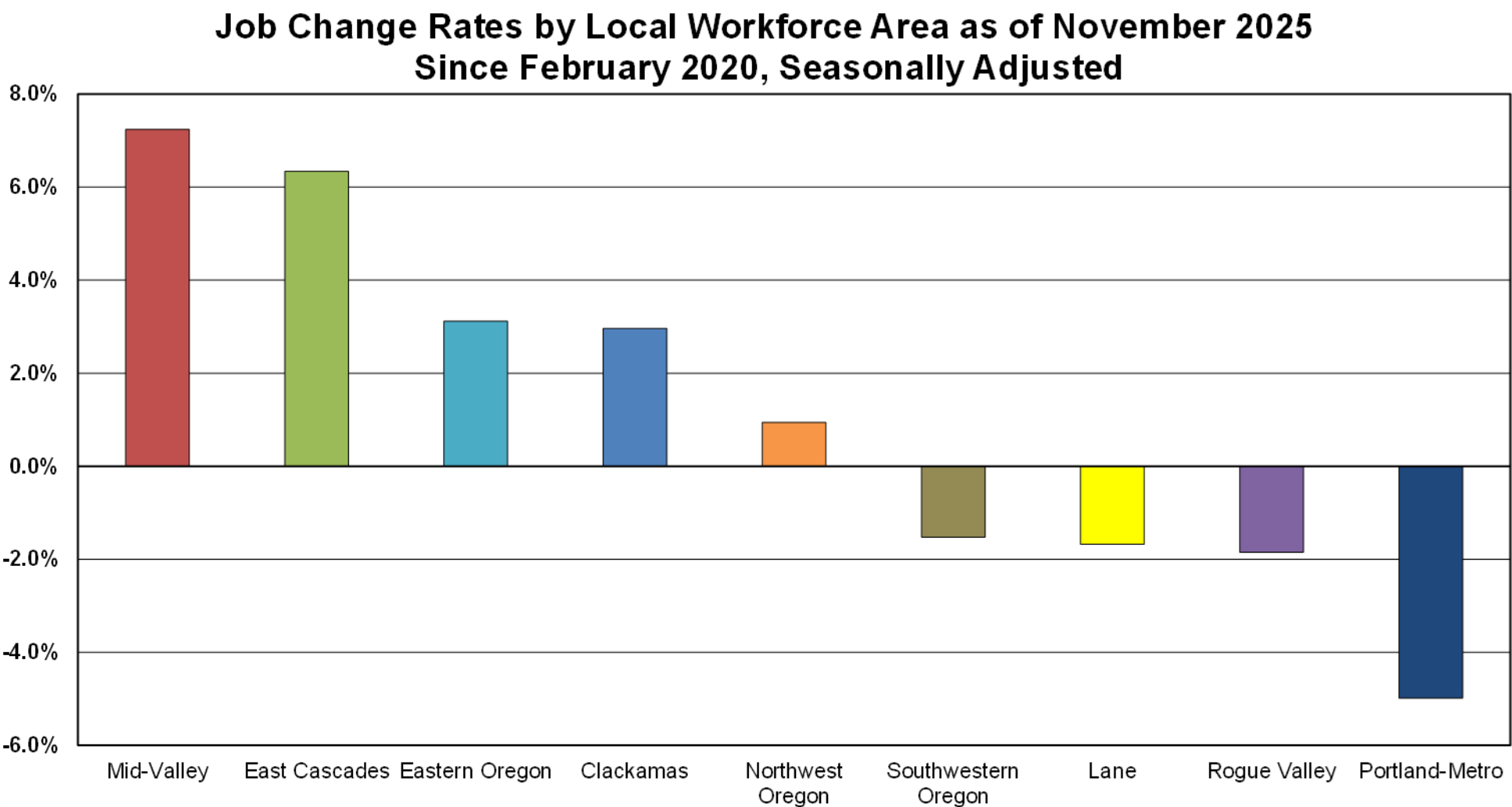
## Employment Change in Oregon's Metro Areas

December 2024 to December 2025, Seasonally Adjusted



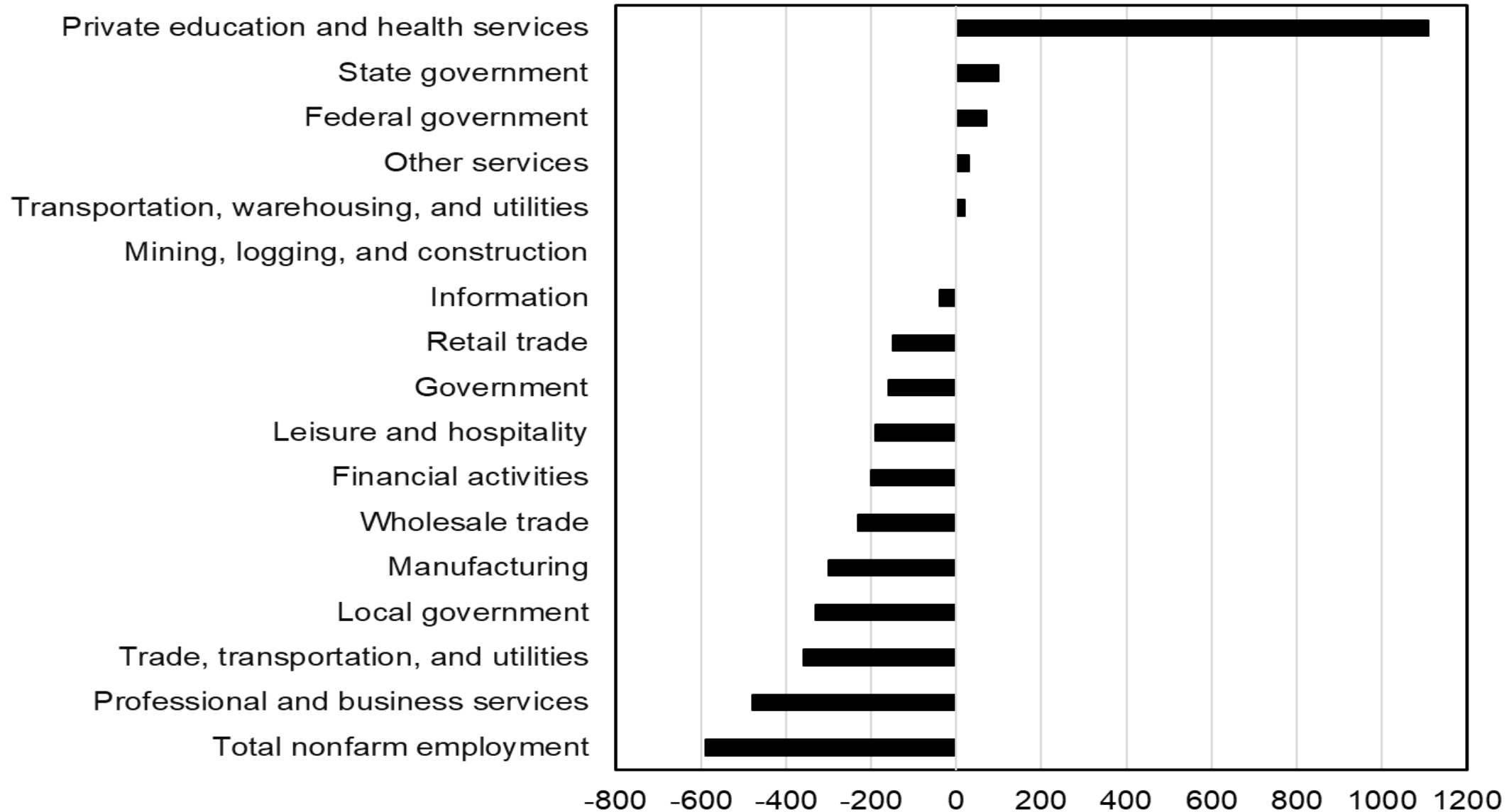

Four of Nine Workforce Areas Have Less Jobs Than Before the Pandemic



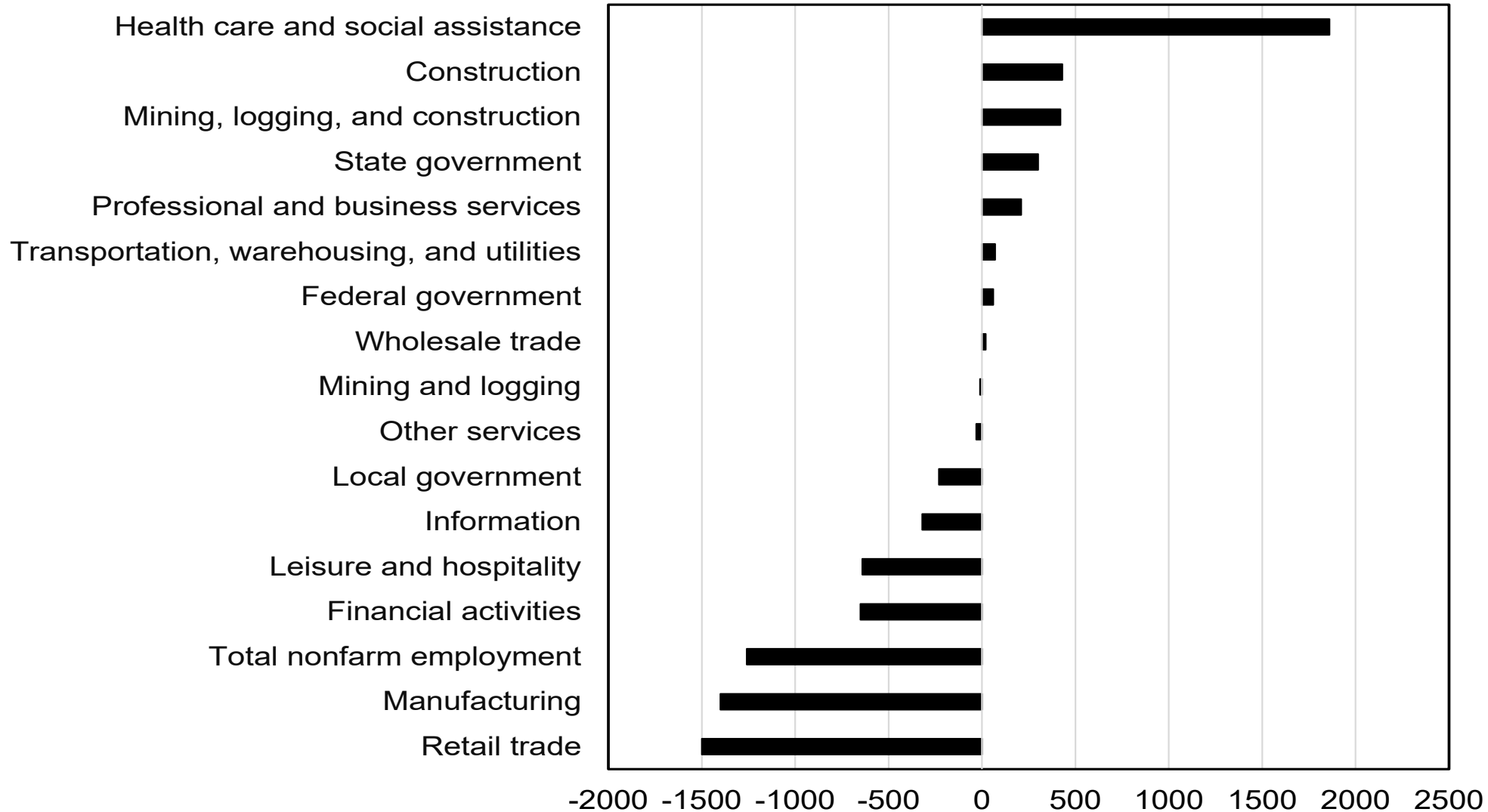

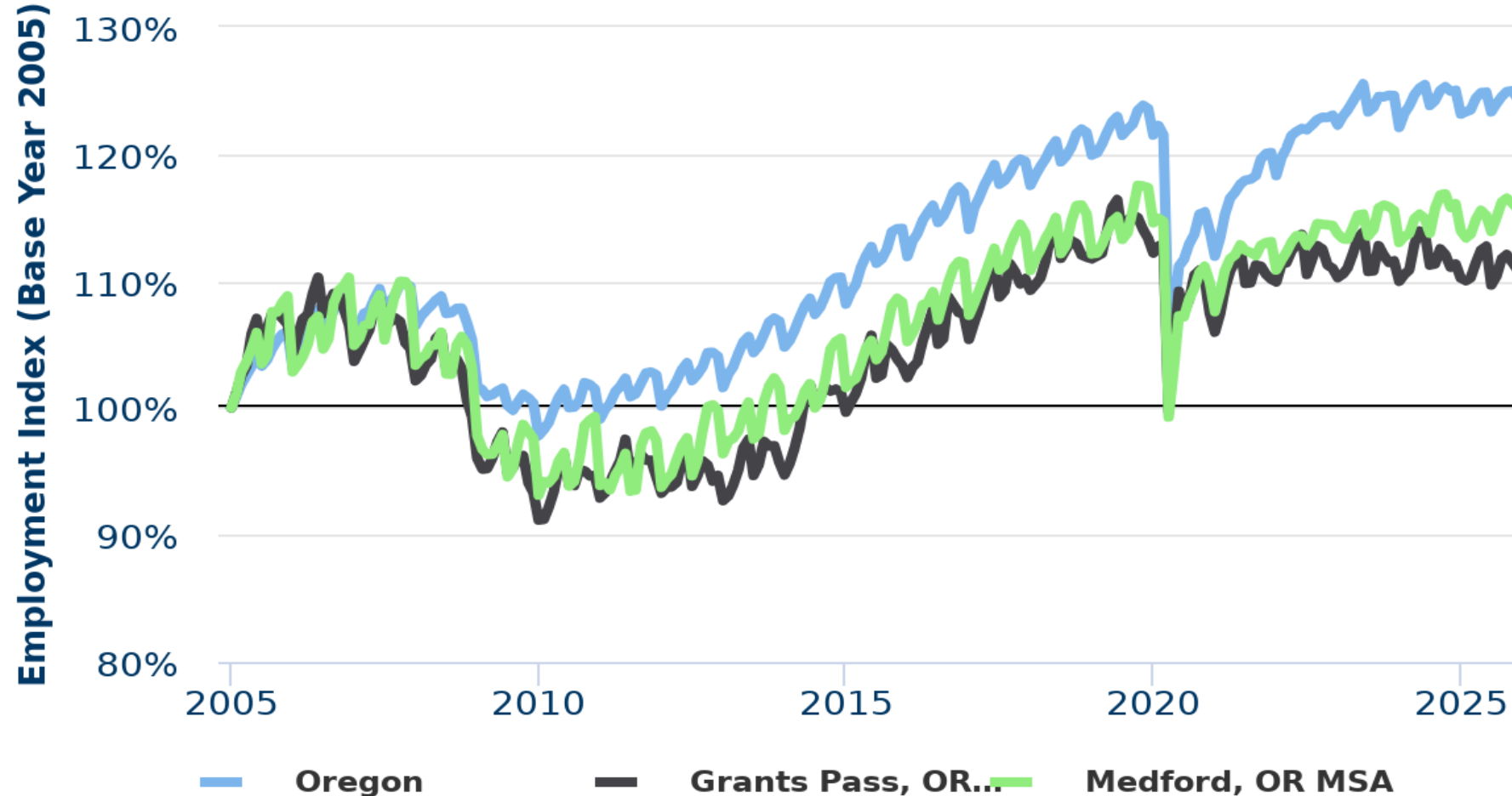
## Jackson County Payroll Employment Change December 2019 to December 2025

Indexed to Show Job Growth Over Time, Base Year 2005



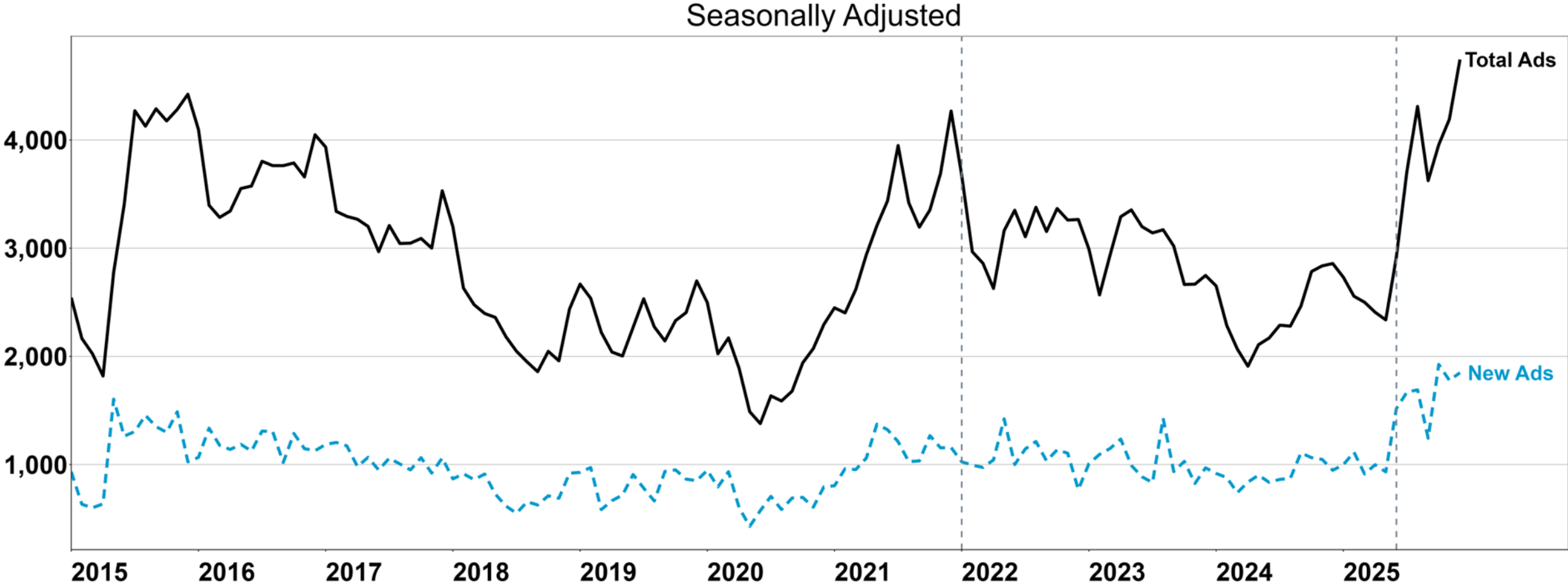

In January 2022, the Conference Board instituted system wide changes to their data collection process to better capture when job ads have expired. As part of these changes, there is an increase in the number of ads that expired, and subsequently, a level change in the data series for Available Ads. The HWOL Index and New Ads series remain unaffected by this update.

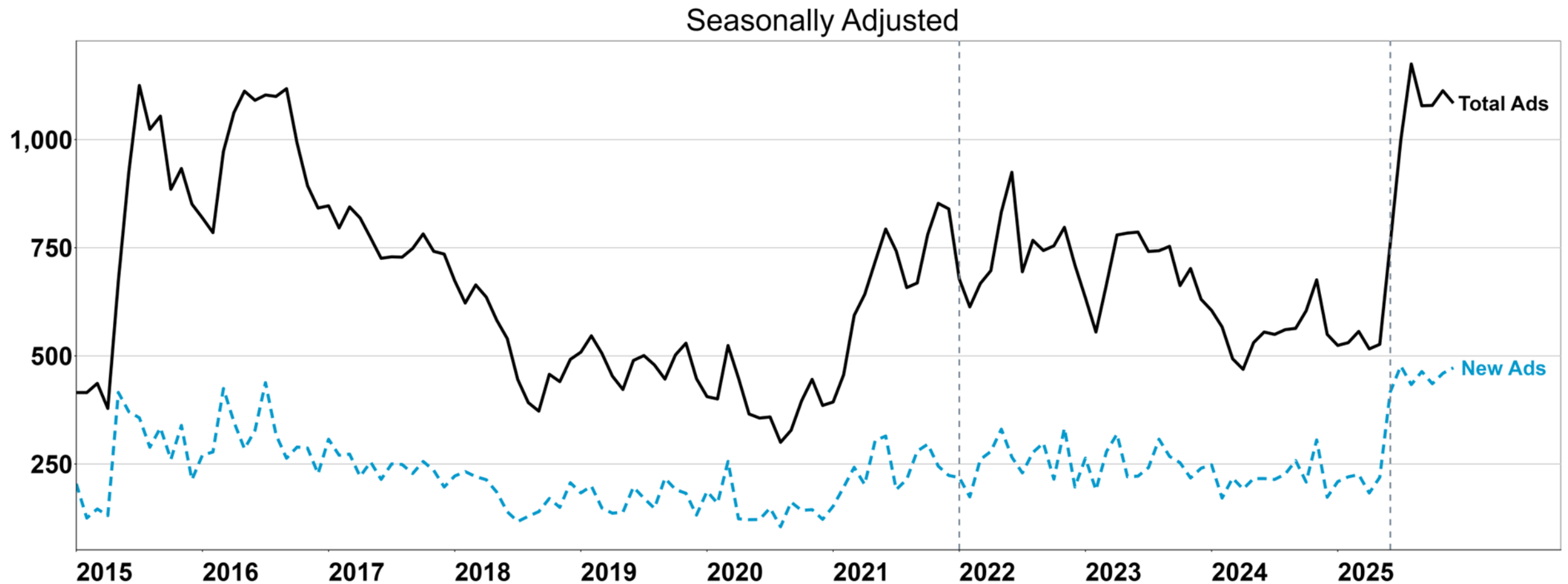
In June 2025, Lightcast and the Conference Board instituted system wide changes to their data collection process to improve coverage of job boards. This could result in level changes in HWOL job posting volume. The HWOL Index remains unaffected by this update.

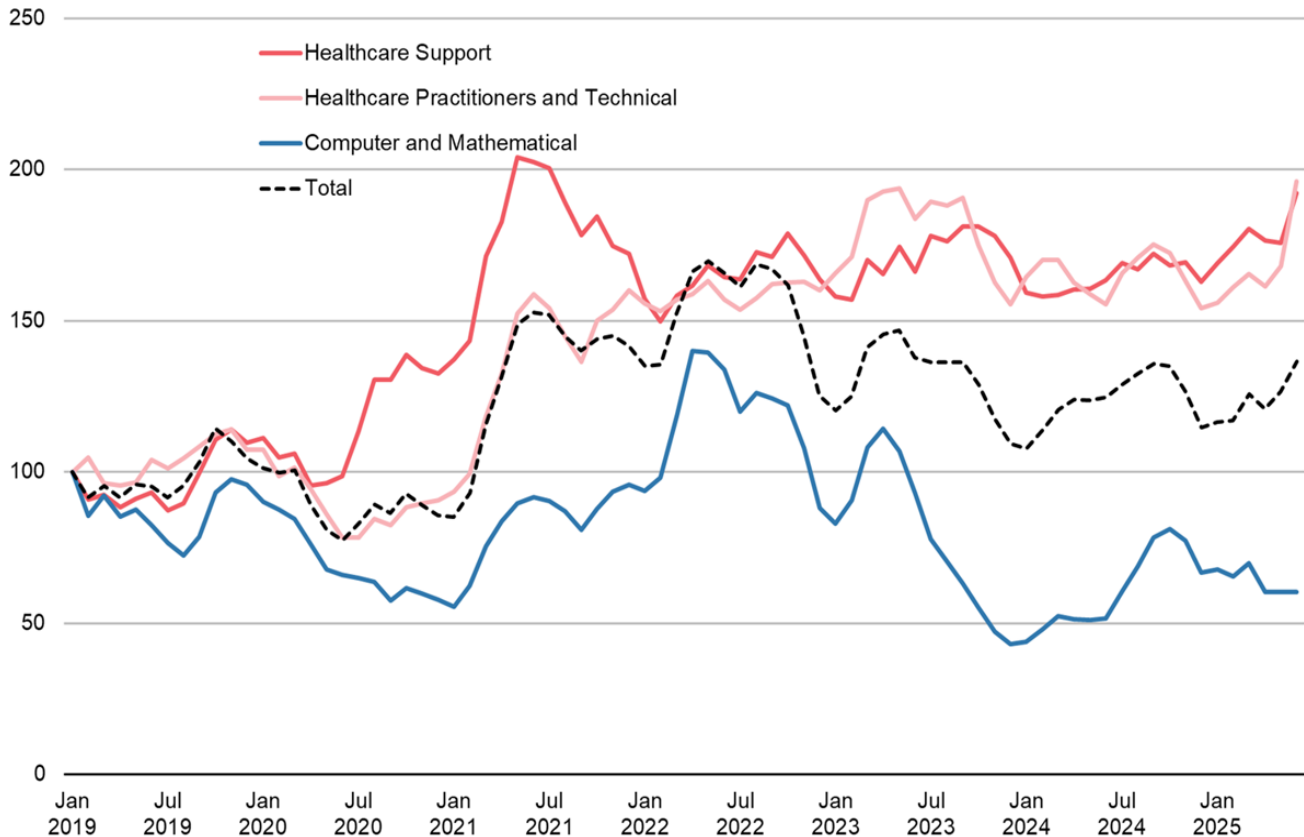

# EMPLOYMENT AND WAGES (WESTERN U.S.)

- Several reports mentioned that fewer workers were switching jobs.
- Multiple contacts reported exploring AI implementation primarily for productivity enhancement and potential future workforce management. AI's current impact on employment was limited, with more significant effects anticipated in the coming years rather than immediately.
- Employers looking to hire received more applications for open positions.
- Nonetheless, difficulties persisted in attracting and retaining workers in engineering fields, mid-level management, health care, and the skilled trades.

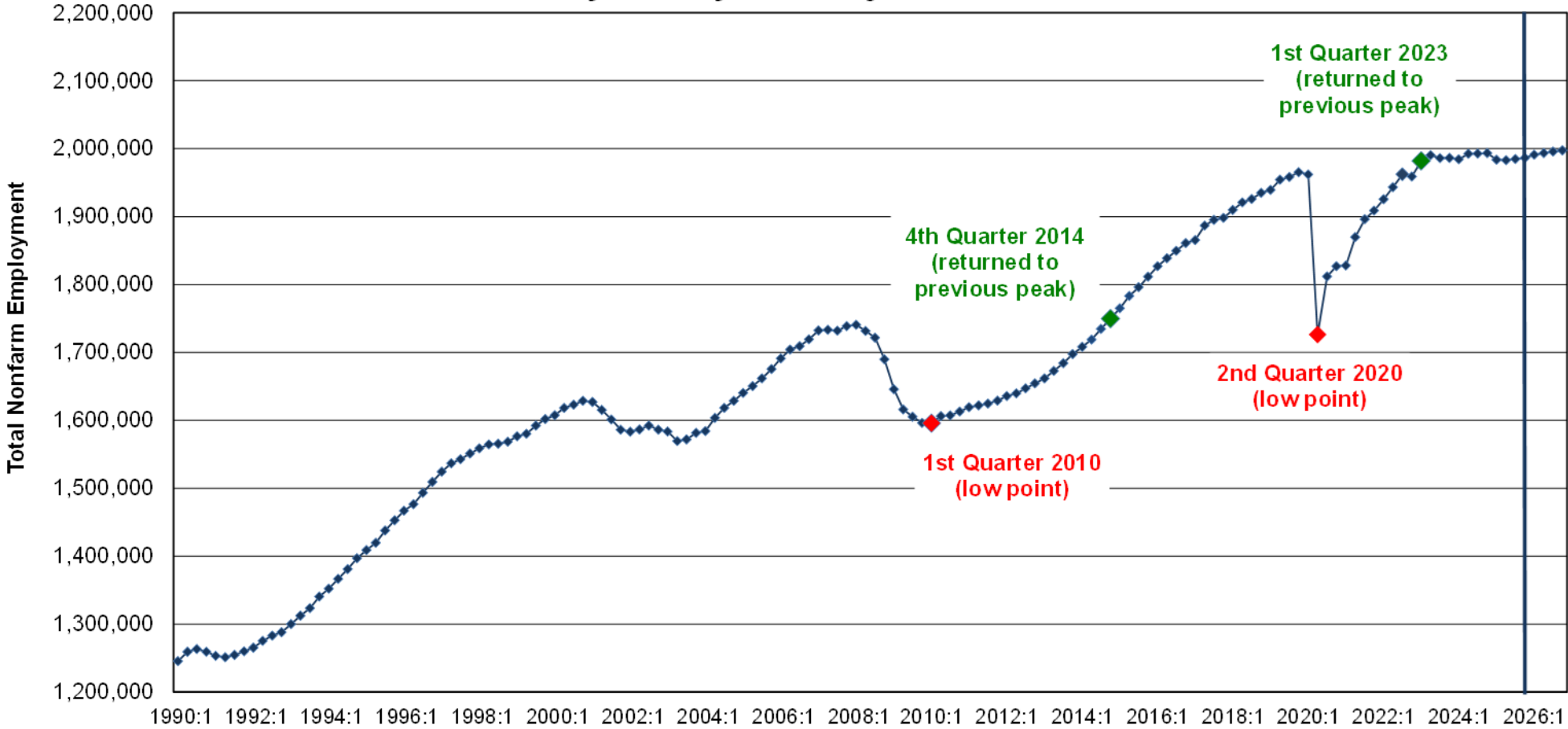
# ECONOMIC ACTIVITY (OREGON AND REGION)

- Economic activity in the Twelfth District (Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, and Washington) expanded modestly during the mid-November through December reporting period.
- Retail sales grew modestly overall, with muted holiday shopping in November giving way to **stronger-than-expected spending in December, stemming mainly from high-income consumers.**
- Employment levels were largely stable, although some contacts reported recent and planned layoffs.
- Conditions in the services, real estate, agriculture, and resource-related sectors were stable on net, while manufacturing activity softened somewhat.
- Lending activity increased slightly, as borrowing rates fell.
- **Demand for community services, particularly for food assistance and childcare, remained high.**
- Wages grew somewhat, and the rate of price increases intensified in recent weeks from a modest to moderate pace.
- Contacts' economic outlook improved slightly since the previous report.

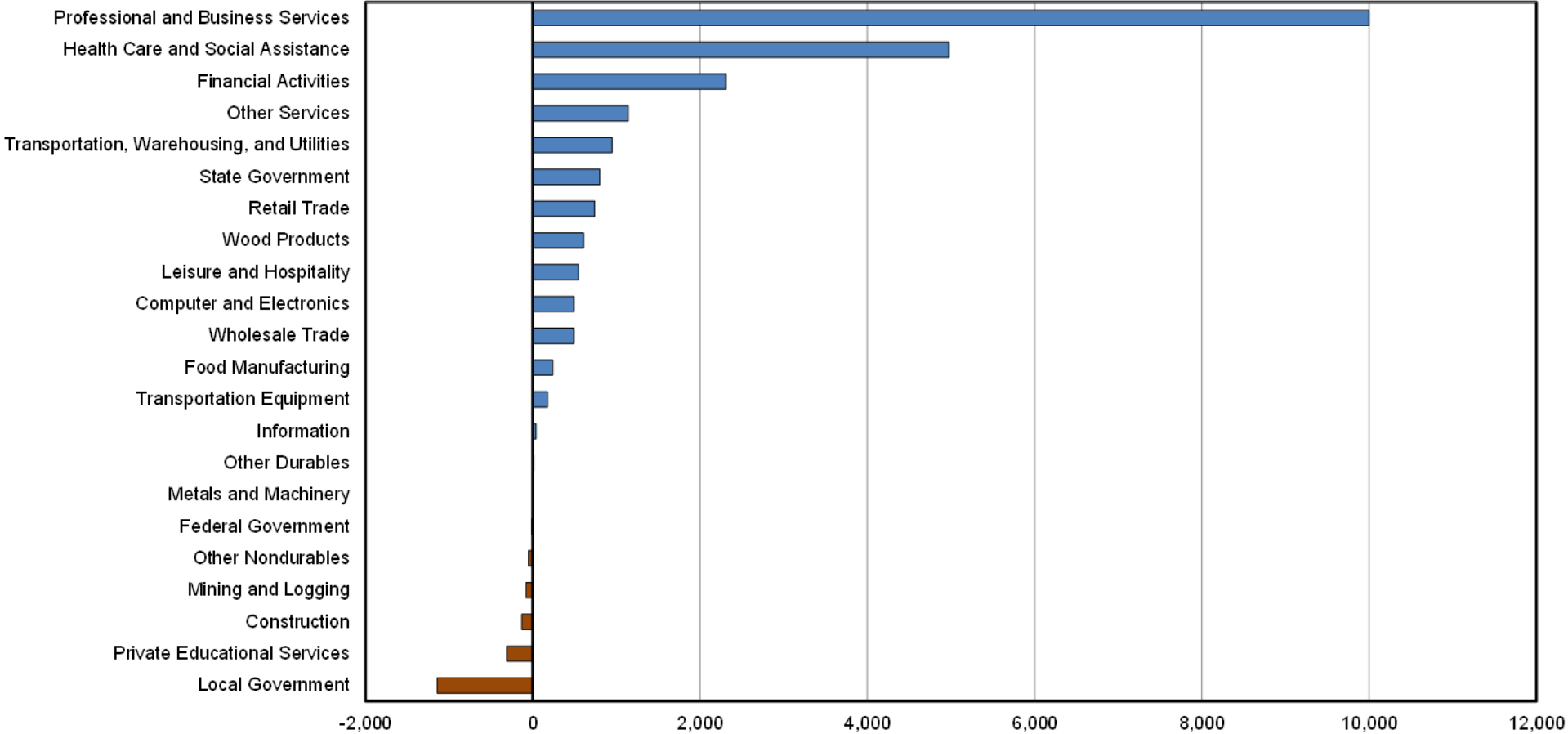
### Oregon Nonfarm Payroll Employment Quarterly History and Projection, 1990-2026
