








## **Tariff Rates Are Generationally High**

U.S Average Effective Tariff Rate Since 1790





#### Exports as a share of gross state product, 2024







Quarterly Data, Percent Change






## Normalized Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (Seasonally-Adjusted)











### Median Sales Price and Inventory, Portland MSA, 12-month moving average

















Job Count [Jobs/Census Block]
