


Unemployment Rates (Seasonally Adjusted)

Nonfarm Employment Change


December 2024 to December 2025

Morrow County gained an estimated 10 jobs over the year, and lost 10 jobs from the previous month. The private sector decreased by 60 jobs and the public sector added 70 jobs from the previous year.

Umatilla County lost an estimated 80 jobs over the year, and lost 250 from the previous month. The private sector decreased by 210 jobs while the public sector added 130 positions over the previous year.

Unemployment Rate News

Both Morrow and Umatilla counties' seasonally adjusted unemployment rates for December 2025 showed no change over the previous month.

Oregon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate still held at 5.2% in December, while the national rate decreased 0.1 percentage point to 4.4%.
