

88% of Klamath County's employment is in service providing industries. The remaining 12% is in goods production.


The public sector employs 5,500 individuals, accounting for nearly a quarter of total employment. These three private sector industries combine for 50% or half of total employment in the county:

- Trade, transportation, and utilities
- Private education and health services
- Leisure and hospitality


Unemployment Rate at 7.5%




The public sector employs over 1,000 individuals, accounting for almost half of total employment. These three private sector industries combine for 28% or over a quarter of total employment in the county:

- Leisure and hospitality


Unemployment Rate at 6.4%
