


# LANE COUNTY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

**Graph of the Month:** Ten-year occupational projections point to continued growth in health care, but the quickest growing and largest growth jobs paint slightly different pictures. High growth roles are more likely to require higher education, and roles adding the most jobs in a more diverse set of industries.
