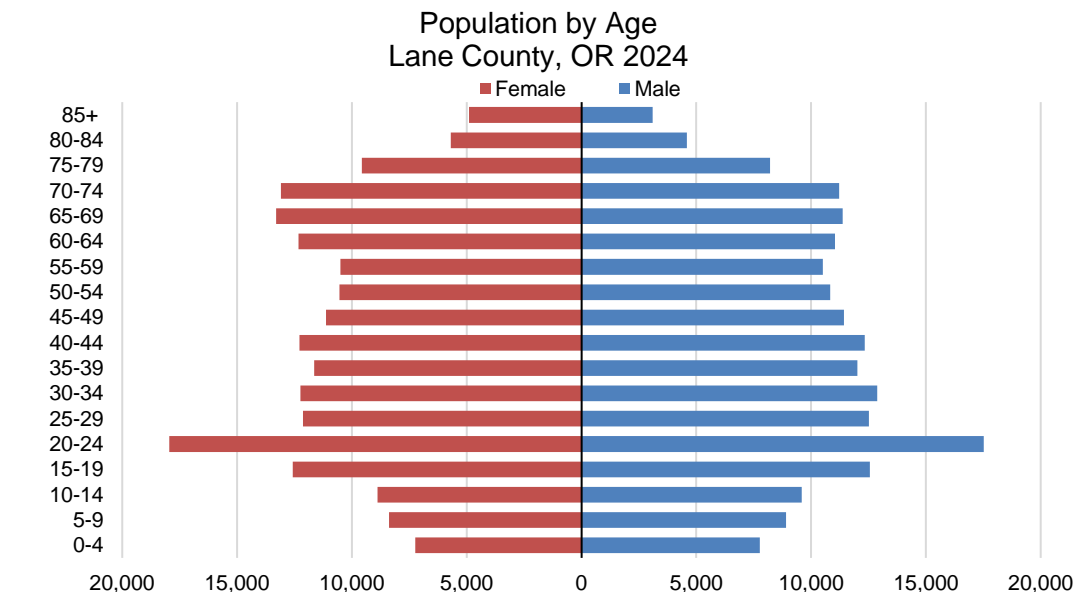


# LANE COUNTY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

**Graph of the Month:** The population of Lane County is slightly older than the state and nation, although educational institutions change the balance. The largest five-year cohort in Lane is 20-24, with more population in the surrounding cohorts than the state, as well as the 60 and older range.
