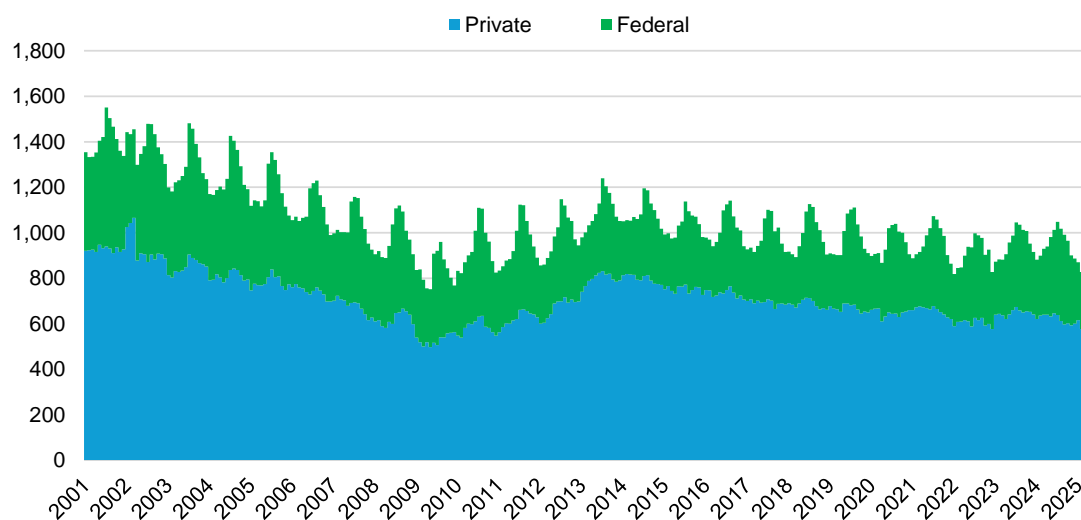


LANE COUNTY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

Graph of the Month: Building on Brian Rooney's [recent article on the forestry and logging industry](#), I looked at employment trends in the sector in Lane. Forestry employment, which is highly seasonal, has declined over 25 years, although Lane has more of the state's industry (11%) than jobs overall (8%).
