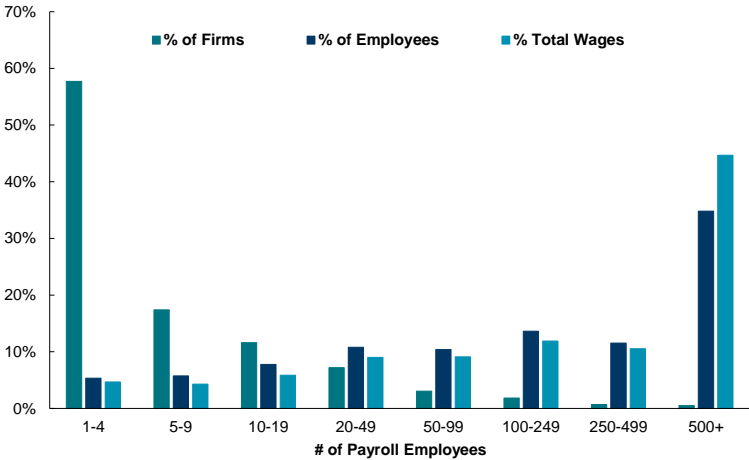


Graph of the Month: Firm size in Washington County. In the first quarter of 2025, 97% of private firms with at least one payroll employee in Washington County had fewer than 100 employees.

Firms with 1 to 4 employees made up 58% of all employers. These firms accounted for about 5% of employment and wages in the first quarter of 2025.

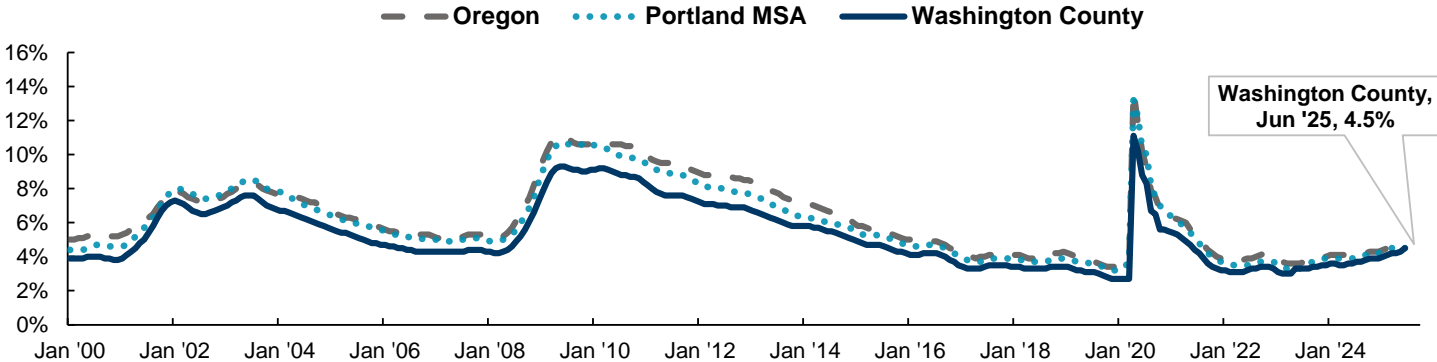
While larger firms made up a smaller share of the total, 3% had 100 or more employees, these firms employed 60% of employees and paid 67% of wages.

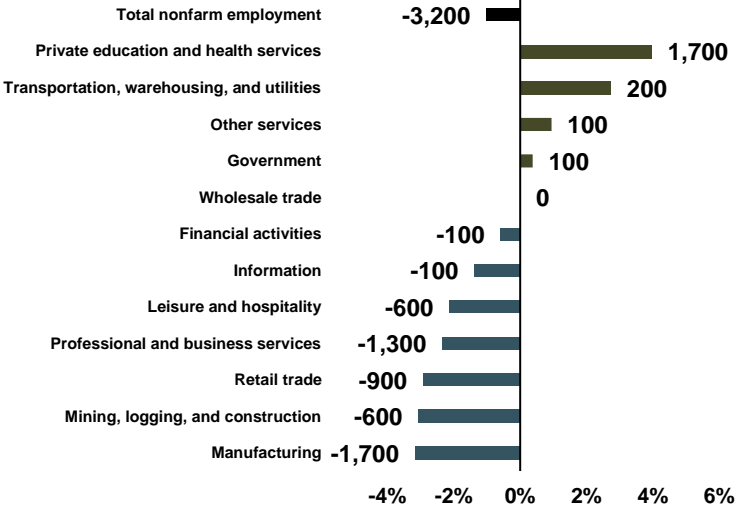
Unemployment in Washington County is at its highest since May 2021—up to 4.5% from 3.6% last year.

Employment in Washington County reached 310,000 in June 2025, a –3,200 decrease from June 2024.

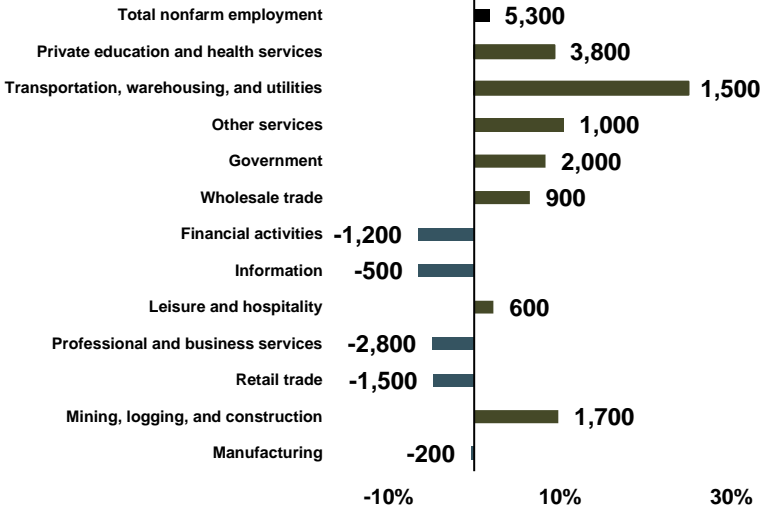
June 2024 to June 2025
