

May 2025 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In May, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in four of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in 32. Eighteen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.8% and four had rates at or below the national rate of 4.2%.

Grant and Klamath counties had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rates in May, both with rates of 6.5%. Josephine County also had a relatively high rate of 6.4%. Hood River County registered the lowest unemployment rate in May at 3.8%. Benton and Sherman counties also had relatively low unemployment rates at 3.9% and 4.0%, respectively.

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate




Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between May 2024 and May 2025, total nonfarm employment rose in four of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in two. Central Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.4%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in the Willamette Valley at 1.1%. Employment growth was slower in Southern Oregon (0.2%) and Eastern Oregon (0.2%). Employment decreased along the Coast (-0.4%) and in the five Portland-Metro counties (-0.6%).
