
June 2025 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In June, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in one of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in 35. Seventeen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.9% and four had rates at or below the national rate of 4.1%.

Grant and Klamath counties had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rates in June, both with rates of 6.7%. Josephine County also had a relatively high rate of 6.6%. Hood River County registered the lowest unemployment rate in June at 3.9%. Benton and Wheeler counties also had relatively low unemployment rates, both at 4.0%.

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between June 2024 and June 2025, total nonfarm employment rose in four of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in two. The Willamette Valley experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 0.9%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in Central Oregon at 0.8%. Employment growth was slower in Eastern Oregon (0.3%) and Southern Oregon (0.1%). Employment decreased along the Coast (-0.5%) and in the five Portland-Metro counties (-0.8%).
