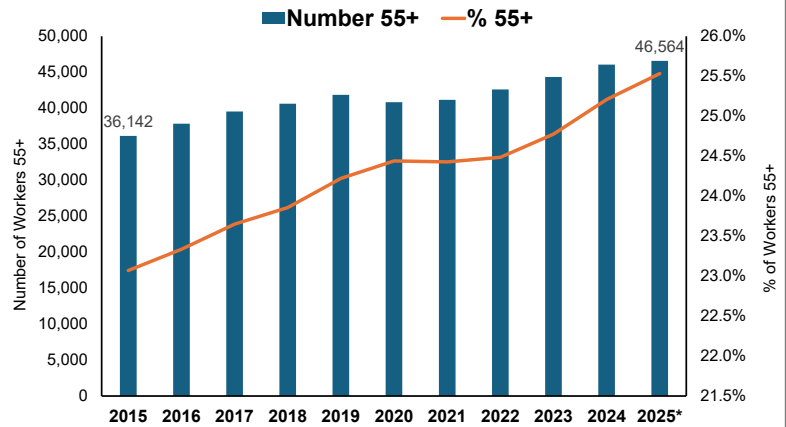

Graph of the Month: Older workers (55+) made up one-quarter of the working labor force in Clackamas County during 2025.

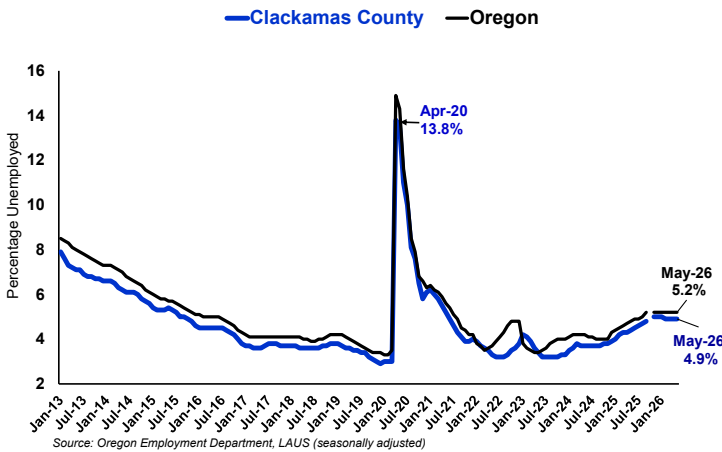
- The number of 55+ older workers in Clackamas County has increased from 36,142 in 2015 to 46,564 in 2025 or by 10,422 workers.
- The share of 55+ older workers grew from 23.1% in 2015 to 25.5% in 2025.
- The sectors with the largest share of 55+ age workers include the agriculture, mining, transportation & warehousing industries.

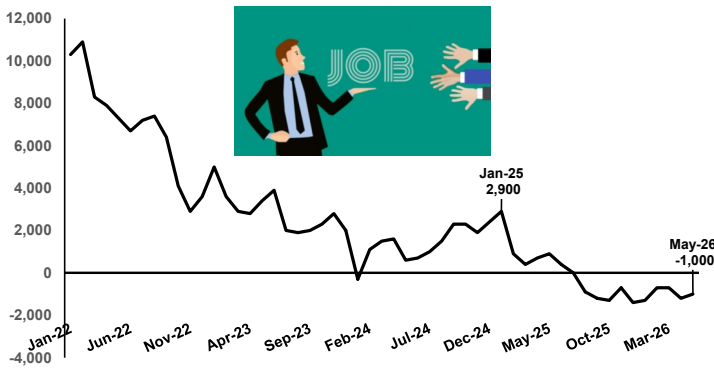
Unemployment Rate Clackamas County & Oregon: 2013-2026

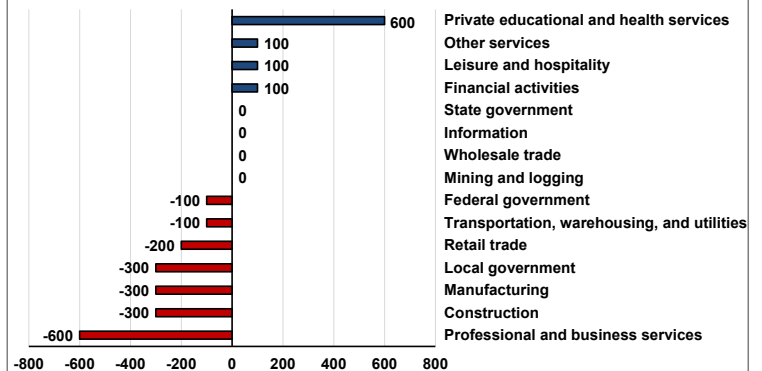
- The *seasonally adjusted* unemployment rate in Clackamas County was 4.9% in May, unchanged from the previous month but higher than a year ago (4.4%).
- Covered employment in Clackamas County reached 172,800 in May, an increase of +500 jobs from the previous month and a decrease of -1,000 jobs from a year ago.
- Net year-to-year job growth from May 2025 to May 2026 saw only four industries adding jobs: private educational and health services (+600); other services (+100); leisure and hospitality (+100); and financial activities (+100). The industries shedding the most jobs included professional and business services; construction; manufacturing; and local government.
