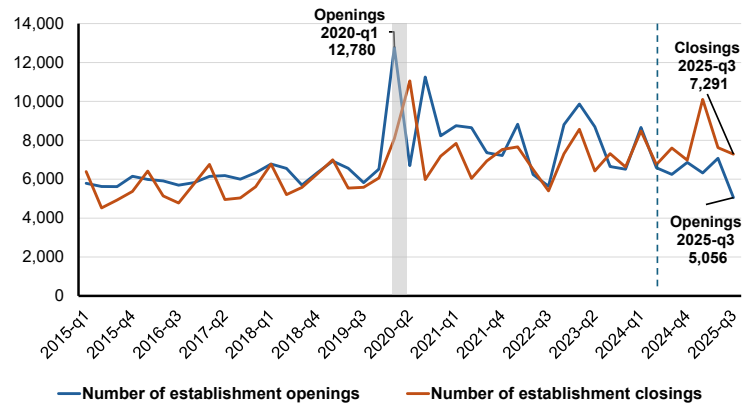

Graph of the Month: Business closures have outnumbered business openings since 2024/q2 in Oregon.

- There have consistently been more business closings than business openings in Oregon each quarter from 2024/q2 to 2025/q3.
- The most current data shows that in 2025/q3, Oregon's business closings outnumbered business openings by 2,235 with 7,291 business closings and 5,056 business openings during that quarter.

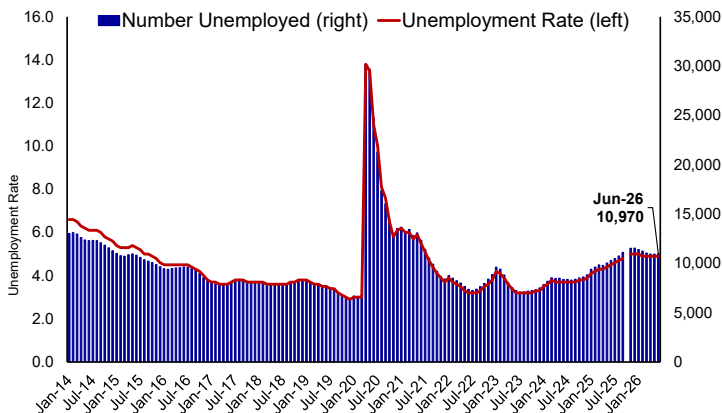


**Number of Business Openings and Closings

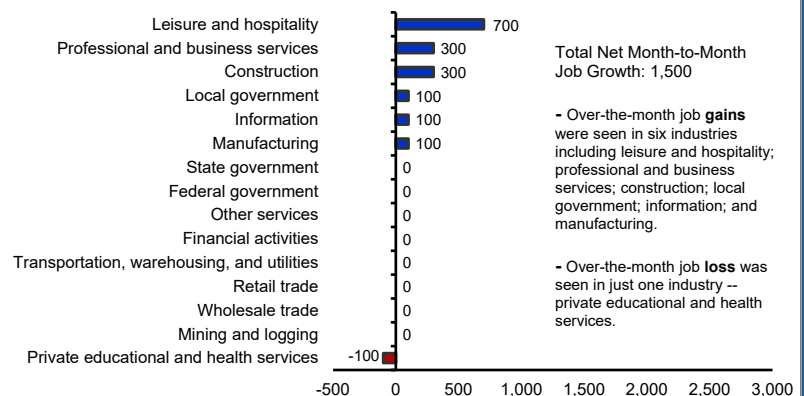
- The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Clackamas County was 4.9% in June – unchanged from the previous month with 10,970 unemployed workers living in the county.
- Covered employment in Clackamas County reached 173,800 in June, an increase of +1,500 jobs from the previous month and a decrease of -800 jobs from a year ago.
- Net month-to-month employment growth from May to June 2026 was at 1,500 jobs.
