ECONOMIC INDICATORS

February 2023 (January data)



- Total nonfarm employment reached 168,800 in January which was -1,600 less jobs than the previous month and 4,200 more than a year ago.
- The unemployment rate (*seasonally adjusted*) reached 3.9% in January from the same rate a year ago. There were 9,076 unemployed residents in Clackamas County in January which was 312 more than a year ago.
- Year-to-year employment grew by 4,200 jobs in January as the majority of broad industries added jobs in the county.



Projected industry employment in the Portland Tri-County is expected to grow by 148,500 jobs or by 15% from 2021-2031.

- Employment projections show the Portland Tri-County's highest job growth will be in accommodation and food services (26,500) and health care and social assistance (22,400).
- The next industries with the highest job growth include professional and technical services (12,500); construction (9,700); government (9,500); and transportation, warehousing, and utilities (9,300).
- Only the finance and insurance industry is expected to lose net employment in the next decade (-400). [Industry Projections, 2021-2031](#)
