

Clackamas County ECONOMIC INDICATORS May 2023 (April data)





- Total nonfarm employment reached 171,300 in April which was a loss of 200 from the previous month and 3,200 more than a year ago. More than threequarters (79%) of the job growth since April 2022 occurred in professional and business services, educational and health services, and construction.
- The *seasonally adjusted* unemployment rate reached 3.6% in April in Clackamas County with 8,040 residents looking for work.
- Clackamas County added 48,741 new residents during the last decade. The largest population gains were seen in Happy Valley, Wilsonville, Oregon City, and Lake Oswego.
