





Pictured to the left are the occupations with the most hiring demand in the last 90 days for Curry County (January 29th—April 28th). The number next to each bar represents how many jobs were posted for that occupation.


During the three month period there were 183 non-duplicated jobs posted online. The number one health care occupation was a physical therapist which appeared in six postings.




