




Continued UI claims in Coos County increased by seven (+2%) over-the-month from June 2023 to July 2023.




Continued UI claims in Curry County increased by 12 (+17%) over-the-month from June 2023 to July 2023.

Continued UI claims increased by 14 (+20%) over-the-year from July 2022 to July 2023.





**Graph of the Month:** Manufacturing employment has declined substantially in Douglas County in the last several decades, principally as a result of the 2008 recession. Durable goods such as wood products and machinery employs fewer than in 2001, while nondurable goods, such as food, has grown.
