

### Help Wanted in the Rogue Valley

Results from the 2022 Job Vacancy Survey



### The Rogue Valley had roughly 8,900 job vacancies at any given time in 2022.

We surveyed 1,700 private employers with two or more employees.

If they were hiring, employers gave details about each vacancy, including:

- Job title
- Full- or part-time status
- Permanent or temporary status
- Starting wage or salary
- Educational and experience requirements

Businesses also identified if their vacancies were difficult to fill, and if so, they wrote in the primary reason they faced hiring challenges.



# Across Oregon, businesses reported roughly 104,000 vacancies at any given time in 2022.



The number of Oregon job vacancies reached record levels in 2022, as the economy recovered from the pandemic recession in 2020. In another record, employers reported about seven out of 10 openings were difficult to fill in 2022.

Other characteristics Oregon employers are looking for didn't change much during the pandemic recession and recovery. A typical job vacancy tends to be for a full-time, permanent position. About one-third require education beyond high school and half require previous experience.



### The number of Rogue Valley vacancies was higher in 2022 than at any time in the survey's history since 2015.







Two-fifths (38%) of vacancies in 2022 had been open for 60 days or longer – up from 36% in 2021. Nine out of 10 of these vacancies were reported as difficult to fill.



### Most (70%) of the Rogue Valley job vacancies required no education beyond high school.


Rogue Valley Job Vacancies by Education Requirement, 2022





### Average hourly wages generally increase along with education requirements for job vacancies...


### Average Hourly Wage for Rogue Valley Job Vacancies by Education Requirement, 2022





### ...and high-paying vacancies are more likely to require education beyond high school.


Share of Rogue Valley Job Vacancies Requiring Education Beyond High School by Hourly Wage Range, 2022

Rogue Valley Job Vacancies by Hourly Wage, 2022






