
February 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In February, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in three of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in 33. Nineteen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.2% and 13 had rates at or below the U.S. unemployment rate of 3.9%.

Crook County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in February at 6.1%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Josephine (5.3%), Gilliam (5.2%), and Lake (5.2%). Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in February at 2.9%. Other counties with relatively low unemployment rates included Hood River (3.2%) and Benton (3.4%).

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between February 2023 and February 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in four of Oregon's six broad regions and fell in two. Eastern Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.8%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in Central Oregon (1.5%) and along the Coast (1.3%). Employment grew at a relatively moderate pace in the Willamette Valley (0.9%). Employment decreased in Southern Oregon (-0.2%) and in the five Portland-metro counties (-0.4%).

Employed includes nonfarm payroll employment, self-employed, unpaid family workers, domestics, agriculture, and labor disputants. Unemployment rate is calculated by dividing unemployed by civilian labor force. Data are not seasonally adjusted unless otherwise noted.
