
The number of U.S. Help Wanted Online ads was 6.2 million in December.

 - California: 645,700










The number of online ads in the Portland metro area was 65,500 in December. The number of new ads decreased by 280 over the month.







The number of online ads in the Salem metro area was 9,300 in December. The number of new ads increased by 380 over the month.




The number of online ads in the Eugene metro area was 8,900 in December. The number of new ads increased by 70 over the month.
















Mid-Valley Help Wanted Online Ads


Lane Help Wanted Online Ads










