


The number of U.S. Help Wanted Online ads was 6.6 million in March.

 - California: 700,000




The number of online ads in Oregon was 97,700 in March. The number of new ads increased by 200 over the month.






The number of online ads in the Portland metro area was 66,200 in March. The number of new ads decreased by 590 over the month.






The number of online ads in the Salem metro area was 9,100 in March. The number of new ads decreased by 140 over the month.




The number of online ads in the Eugene metro area was 8,300 in March. The number of new ads increased by 70 over the month.























Lane Help Wanted Online Ads


East Cascades Help Wanted Online Ads








