## Note

As of January 2022, Emsi Burning Glass has instituted system wide changes to their data collection process to better capture when job ads have expired. As part of these changes, there is an increase in the number of ads that expired, and subsequently, a level change in the data series for Available Ads. The HWOL Index and New Ads series remain unaffected by this update.



### The number of U.S. Help Wanted Online ads was 6.8 million in October.

- Number of ads posted in Oregon totaled 119,100 in October.
- Number of ads posted for the first time (new ads) increased by 70 in Oregon in October.
- Nationally, new ads decreased by 34,800 in October.

Nevada: 83,400






### The number of help wanted ads in Oregon was 119,100 in October. The number of new ads increased by 70 over the month.






#### The number of help wanted ads nationally was 6.8 million in October 2022.








### The number of online ads in the Portland metro area was 76,700 in October. The number of new ads decreased by 430 over the month.






## The number of online ads in the Salem metro area was 12,500 in October. The number of new ads increased by 20 over the month.






## The number of online ads in the Eugene metro area was 9,700 in October. The number of new ads decreased by 190 over the month.






## The number of online ads in the Medford metro area was 2,800 in October. The number of new ads increased by 100 over the month.






### The number of online ads in the Bend metro area was 4,400 in October. The number of new ads increased by 130 over the month.






## The number of online ads in the Corvallis metro area was 3,000 in October. The number of new ads increased by 60 over the month.






## The number of online ads in the Albany metro area was 2,500 in October. The number of new ads increased by 90 over the month.






## The number of online ads in the Grants Pass metro area was 720 in October. The number of new ads decreased by 100 over the month.


















