


The number of U.S. Help Wanted Online ads was 5.6 million in February.

- Number of ads posted in Oregon totaled 87,800 in February.
- Number of ads posted for the first time (new ads) increased by 5,700 in Oregon in February.
- Nationally, new ads increased by 123,700 in February.

 - Nevada: 69,600
 - Oregon: 87,800

 - California: 626,600




The number of online ads in Oregon was 87,800 in February. The number of new ads increased by 5,700 over the month.





The number of help wanted ads nationally was 5.6 million in February 2023.









The number of online ads in the Portland metro area was 58,000 in February. The number of new ads increased by 2,600 over the month.






The number of online ads in the Salem metro area was 10,400 in February. The number of new ads increased by 1,900 over the month.








The number of online ads in the Eugene metro area was 7,500 in February. The number of new ads increased by 30 over the month.






The number of online ads in the Medford metro area was 2,200 in February. The number of new ads increased by 10 over the month.







The number of online ads in the Bend metro area was 2,400 in February. The number of new ads increased by 210 over the month.






The number of online ads in the Corvallis metro area was 2,100 in February. The number of new ads increased by 220 over the month.









The number of online ads in the Albany metro area was 2,000 in February. The number of new ads increased by 90 over the month.










Mid-Valley Help Wanted Online Ads






Lane Help Wanted Online Ads

Not Seasonally Adjusted






East Cascades Help Wanted Online Ads






Clackamas Help Wanted Online Ads






Rogue Valley Help Wanted Online Ads








Southwestern Oregon Help Wanted Online Ads
