




#### Gross Domestic Product rose from \$2.18 billion in 2020 to \$2.29 billion in 2021 in Coos County












#### Coos County Labor Force Data





COVID-19 Job Changes Compared to Great Recession Job Changes













#### Coos County Payroll Employment Change by Industry May 2019 - May 2023



#### Curry County Payroll Employment Change by Industry May 2019 - May 2023





#### Curry County Seasonally Adjusted Total Non-Farm Employment




